9. Why do you think the author of Source 3 remember Ellis Island so clearly decades later?

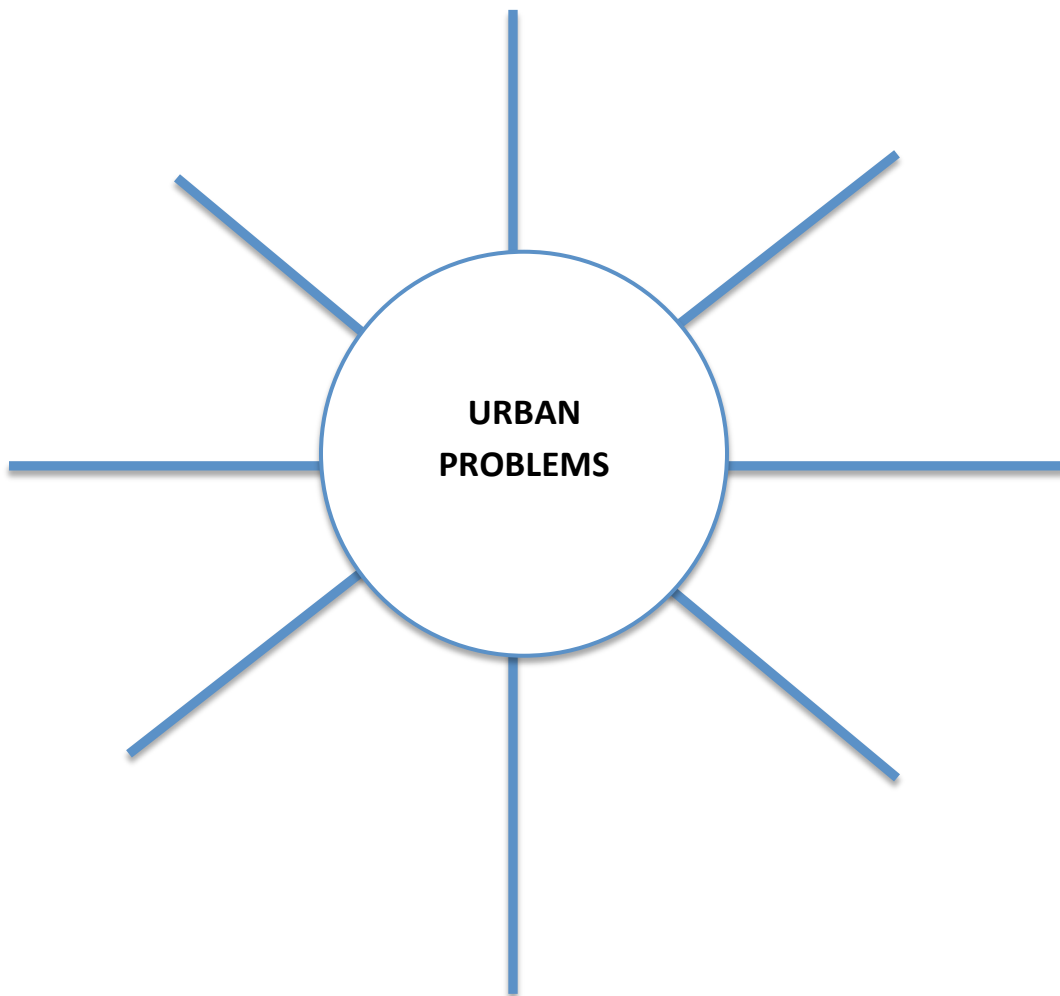
10. According to Lee Chew in Source 4, what were some factors that helped him adapt as a n immigrant and become a small business owner?
